Description

Neck-amphora; lip with echinus profile, triple handles, torus foot. Palmette and lotus chain on neck; black and red tongue pattern on shoulder; floral motifs of four palmettes and three lotuses beneath handles; friezes of rays, upright lotus buds, and zig-zag dots between thin reserved bands on lower body.
